India Hosts a Virtual SCO Summit

At the 23rd Leaders' Summit of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) hosted by India, Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid out five pillars of the SCO's vision: security, economic development and connectivity, unity, respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, and environmental protection. This Summit was held virtually on July 04, 2023.

Apart from leaders of this eight-member organisation, the President of Turkmenistan was the Guest of the Chair, and the Presidents of Belarus, Iran and Mongolia, who are observers, also participated.
