#### India, U.S. hold fifth 2+2 Ministerial Dialogue with focus on Indo-Pacific

In the month of November 2023 New Delhi hosted 2+2 Ministerial Dialogues with two of its comprehensive strategic partners who are also members of the QUAD. India's External Affairs Minister and Defence Minister met with their counterparts from the U.S. on November 09-10 and Australia on November 20. For covering this, CUTS International came up with an Occasional News Wrap (ONW):

• India Hosts Two 2+2 Ministerial Dialogues

Apart from this, an inter-ministerial delegation from India attended the 28th Session of the UN Climate Change Conference (COP28) held in Dubai, United Arab Emirates from November 30, 2023 to December 13, 2023. The major outcome from COP28 included the decision on Outcome of the First Global Stocktake, ratcheting up global climate ambition before the end of the decade.

These global efforts will be taken up by the countries in a nationally determined manner taking into account the Paris Agreement and their different national circumstances. Another major outcome of COP 28 is the agreement on the operationalisation of the Loss and Damage Fund and its funding arrangements.

Also, in this quarter United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD's) 8th World Investment Forum, was hosted in Abu Dhabi from October 16-20, 2023. This Biennial Forum assembled over 6,000 investment stakeholders from 160 countries, including high-level participants such as Heads of State, Global Company Executives, and Experts in the international investment landscape. Here, CUTS in partnership with the International Labour Organisation (ILO) and UNCTAD also hosted an event titled <u>"FDI, ESG and Inclusivity"</u>.

In this quarter, CUTS organised a workshop third in-series in Mumbai, Maharashtra with distinguished speakers to facilitate meaningful dialogues to understand broader perspectives of the U.S.-India Defense Partnership:

U.S., India, Taiwan unite to strengthen cybersecurity against China threat Business Standard December 13, 2023	With China looming ever larger as a potent cyber threat, American, Indian and Taiwanese cybersecurity officials have met to find ways of deepening their operational expertise and sharing best practices on <u>cybersecurity issues</u> . The meeting took place on December 11, and December 12 during a joint workshop convened under the Global Cooperation and Training Framework (GCTF). This was the first in-person GCTF programme held in India. NASA Administrator to travel to India, UAE; Discuss Space Cooperation NASA, Abbey A. The program, dubbed next-generation microelectronics manufacturing, will fund the research and equipment to create a domestic center for prototyping cutting-edge fabrication techniques, which DARPA hopes will give the U.S. semiconductor industrial base a leading edge.
